
Short biography Joy Lohmann:

Joy is a German artist, designer and climate activist. He works in the field of socialsculpture, streetart and site-specific performance. Since his first floating island, made of upcycled materials for the world fair EXPO2000 in his hometown Hanover, he focusses on floating installations. Joy's art is mostly realized in public spaces and was exhibited at BAUHAUS/Dessau, at the documenta fifteen, in galleries and on travelling (or floating) exhibitions in many countries; his "flow-garden" won the international "Social-Art-Award 2021". The ongoing "Open-Island" project series was documented in books, articles and the cinema movie "Träum weiter" (Dream on), 2021. With the Makers-For-Humanity collective, he just won the "Ocean Future Lab" hackathon and works now on a global open-source repository for appropriate knowledge for climate resilience on/with water.
